THE NEW CHAIRMAN OF THE EDITORIAL BOARD OF THE CENTRAL EUROPEAN JOURNAL OF PUBLIC HEALTH, PROFESSOR MUDr. MILAN TUČEK, CSc.

On 22 September 2025, Professor MUDr. Milan Tuček, CSc., was appointed by the Director of the National Institute of Public Health in Prague as the new Chairman of the Central European Journal of Public Health, replacing Chairwoman Professor Milena Černá, DrSc., who stood at the helm of the Journal since 2003.

Professor Milan Tuček is a respected specialist in the fields of hygiene, epidemiology, occupational medicine, and public health. His career began at the Public Health Station in Klatovy, and subsequently at the Regional Public Health Station in Pilsen, where he was Head of the Occupational Health and Medicine Department, later becoming a regional public health officer and Director of the Regional Public Health Station from 1990 to 1997. He has also worked at the National Institute of Public Health in Prague and the Czech Railway Health Services a.s. From 2009 to 2023, he held the post of Head of the Institute of Hygiene and Epidemiology, First Faculty of Medicine, Charles University,

where he continues his professional activities. Since 2003 he has held the post of Chairman of Occupational Medicine of the Czech Medical Association of J. E. Purkyně. He is actively involved in international collaboration and is a delegate of the Occupational Medicine of UEMS (European Union of Medical Specialists) as well as UIMC (International Union of Railway Medical Services). For his contribution to the development of occupational medicine, he received the Professor Teisinger Memorial Medal, which is awarded for exceptional contributions to the field. In 2023, he received the honorary title of Doctor Honoris Causa in the field of occupational safety (Salus laborem) from the Expert Institute of Health Safety and Protection for his lifelong achievement in occupational health.

He has been a member of the Editorial Board since 2014.
